Required Prerequisites: *Four51 Admin Fundamentals or the completed proficiency exam.*

Suggested Prerequisites: *A design background, familiarity with Quark and InDesign, basic Photoshop skills.*

Who should attend:

This course is essential for any user who will be responsible for creating and managing variable products on customers' sites. Four51 Certified Designer training is also a great course for anyone who wants to really understand the variable print capabilities of the Four51 application.

What you will learn:

This intensive three-day session covers Pageflex configurations in the Four51 application and will teach you to setup, implement, and manage users, customers and products—including variable products. This course teaches the essential Pageflex skills required to build and implement variable templates on the application.

To complete this course and gain certification, you will need to pass a final test demonstrating the skills you have learned.
